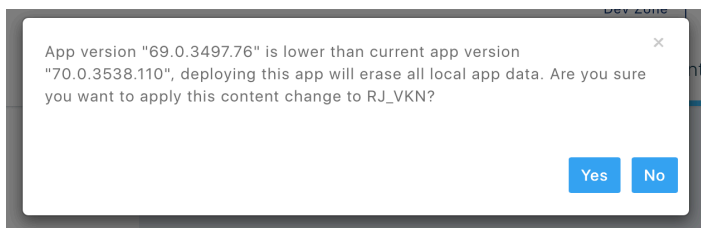

The EloView product team is excited to announce a major feature release. This update focuses on stability and customer requested improvements, including vulnerability patches from Android. Here is a list of new features and fixes with their short explanations:

APK Downgrading – Version Code Warning

To ensure the operators of EloView Cloud are publishing the correct content on their devices, the EloView Team will be tracking your APKs from now on. EloView will warn you in case you are publishing an older version of the same APK. Please be aware that “the APK downgrading warning feature” works only for newly uploaded APKs.



Account Settings Editing and Confirmation Alert

To help prevent unwanted setting changes from being released, we have added an extra confirmation to apply changes. Please note, “Account Settings” still maintains restricted access which is determined by role permissions. This update simply provides an additional check before you apply a change that you made since it will affect all the devices and groups on your platform.

Other Fixes

Bugs fixes have been addressed related to Content Deletion, User Data and Cookies, Device Status in real time, APP Reinstallation and Device Reboots. And we have applied the latest Android vulnerability patches to increase the security and privacy.



Method of Distribution

This update will be available to apply via Advanced OTA on December 5, 2018 and will become the default to update from the device control panel on December 12, 2018. There is no downtime associated with this update. As always, your devices will never prompt for an update or auto-update. Once the update is available, devices can be updated from the EloView Portal or at the device-level from the EloView Control Panel.
